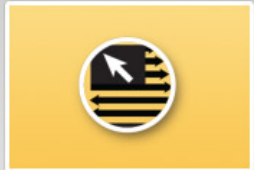

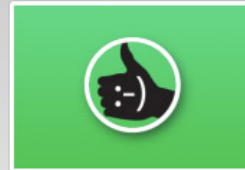

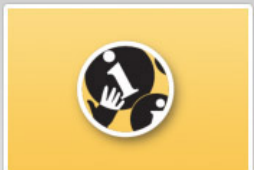

### INFRASTRUCTURE

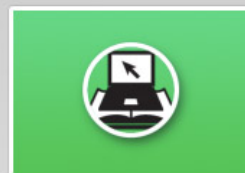
The physical and institutional channels that support the delivery and flow of information in a community, and the organizations involved in the verification, filtering, sorting and dissemination of information.

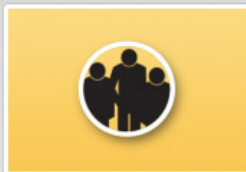

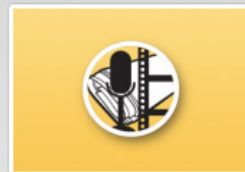
