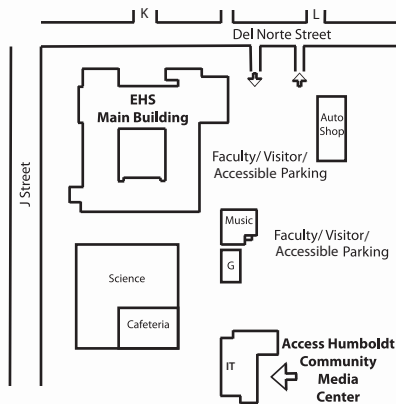

## COMMUNITY MEDIA CENTER

Access Humboldt's Community Media Center (CMC) serves as a regional hub for broadband communications and digital media.

Members of Access Humboldt can make use of the production studio, editing facilities, and check out equipment for field work at the CMC.

Digital Media workstations are open to members' use and encompass video, audio, graphics and animation editing capability.

## EQUIPMENT RENTAL & STUDIO TIME

Members of Access Humboldt who attended an Orientation and a Basic Field Certification can check out cameras, microphones, tripods, and lights for their own production. Studio Certification class allows members to reserve and use the studio facility.



## CLASSES & TRAINING

### ORIENTATION

**1** Offered at no charge to members of Access Humboldt. This two-hour overview of the Community Media Center is a prerequisite for all facility use and member benefits. Attendees will be given a full tour of the CMC and introduced to the resources and procedures of Access Humboldt. Members will be certified to check out Flip video cameras and add their name & talents to HIP (Humboldt Interactive Pool).

### BASIC FIELD CERTIFICATION

**2** This three-hour course covers the proper use and handling of the basic field production equipment available for check out from AH, as well as proper check-out policies and procedures.

### BASIC STUDIO CERTIFICATION

**3** This four-hour session will allow you to reserve studio space and produce content for the channels in our in-house High-Definition production facility.
