Videos submitted by community members. This is an uncensored, non-commercial forum for your voice.

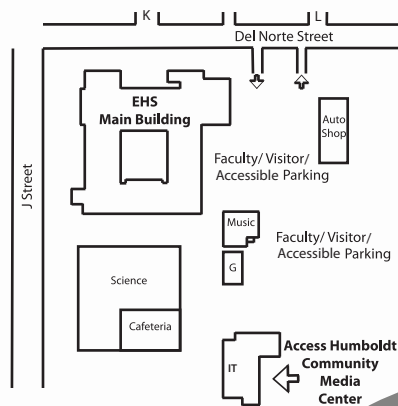

## POLICY EXCERPTS:\*

### WHAT'S ALLOWED, WHAT'S NOT

**Underwriting** - Businesses or individuals may donate a specific product, service, or funding to assist an access program in return for non-commercial acknowledgment on that program.

**Commercial content** is prohibited on AH's community access TV channels. AH defines commercial content as information that is designed for the purpose of personal financial gain.

**Safe Harbor:** Programs that contain sexually explicit content, nudity, offensive language, or excessively violent material are considered adult programming and must satisfy certain requirements in order to be aired.
